1.0. CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Makio at 3:09 p.m., and roll call was conducted.

2.0. APPROVAL OF MINUTES (January 26, 2015 Meeting)

The Chair opened the floor for review and discussion on the minutes of January 26, 2015.

Motion Marilyn Salas motioned to approve the minutes as read.
The motion was seconded by Eric Forbes and unanimously approved.

3.0. OLD BUSINESS

No Discussion.

4.0. NEW BUSINESS

4.1. Atantano Appraisal

Joe Quinata reported the appraisal for the Atantano property was completed and appraised at \$9.9 million. The appraised value needs Board's approval before recording into the assets of the Trust and for the audit.

Chairman Makio reported the Architect Committee reviewed the appraisal which was predicated on the property's use, and M-1 industrial zoning which raises the residual value of the property because of the potential for development.

GPT is allowed to own properties and use its assets to leverage additional funding to augment Trust funds for programs and projects.

Motion With no further discussion, Marilyn Salas motioned to approve the appraisal of the Atantano property and allow the appraisal value to enter into the books for recording.

The motion was seconded by Eric Forbes.
 The floor was opened for discussion.
 The Board discussed the existing refinery and the potential site for the incinerator project.
 Joe Quinata reported a ridge buffers the refinery from the property.
 Staff will coordinate a Board visit of the property.

With no further discussion, the motion was unanimously approved.

4.2. Guam History and Chamorro Heritage Day

Joe Quinata reported Humatak Mayor Johnny Quinata submitted a letter requesting GPT's sponsorship for the 2015 Guam History & Chamorro Heritage Day.
 The Board discussed GPT's participation in the past years and requesting detailed accountability of the use of GPT's funds specifically towards historic preservation activities.
 Joaquin Perez raised concerns on the FQ Sanchez School.

Motion Marilyn Salas motioned that GPT support the Humatak Mayor's request for sponsorship with a condition that they showcase the activities in historic preservation.
 The motion was seconded by Joaquin Perez with an amendment that no one interprets GPT's funding support of turning F.Q. Sanchez into an elementary school.
 The floor was opened for discussion.

Eric Forbes requested that it include a detail of the use of funds and to be addressed at the next meeting.

Motion- Withdrawn Marilyn Salas withdrew the initial motion.
 Joaquin Perez seconded the motion to withdraw.
 With no objections the motion was withdrawn.

Motion Marilyn Salas motioned to provide support of \$5,000.00, as requested by the Mayor of Humatak for the Guam History and Chamorro Heritage event with three (3) conditions: 1) It does not to imply the support comingles with the use of the FQ Sanchez School; 2) provide a written statement of how they will showcase the use of funds in historic preservation; and (3) submit a final report upon completion.
 The motion was seconded by Joaquin Perez.
 With no further discussion the motion was unanimously approved.

Staff was asked to insert the dates for their report submissions.

5.1. Budget & Finance Report

 Joe Quinata reported the current fund balance is \$6,522,773.19 with a total of \$5,005,891.07, available for grants and projects.
 Chairman Makio reported a meeting will be scheduled with the current investment companies to provide an update on GPT's profile and investment efforts.
- Joe Quinata reported the approved appraisal will be forwarded to the accounting firm for recording of assets and will be reflected in the financial statement.
- Info** **5.1.b. FY14 Audit**
 Joe Quinata reported on the completion and clean audit for FY2014.
 Only one adjustment to record the appraisal of the Atantano property was noted.
 No other major findings were cited.
 Chairman Makio noted the Public Auditor's involvement in GPT's audit is simply the chain of custody of the funds that comes from the Government of Guam.
- Joe Quinata presented a draft Management Discussion and Analysis (MD&A) which translates the figures in the financial statement into an explanation of the organization, highlights, and financial standings.
 The Public Auditor will be issuing highlights of the Audit after submission of the final draft and the MD&A.

- 5.2.a. San Dionisio Church – Structural Assessment**
 Joe Quinata reported the engineering firm of Duenas and Camacho submitted a proposal of \$37,336.54, to conduct the structural assessment of the San Dionisio C Church. The architect committee reviewed the proposal and requested clarification on three (3) items: 1) the charge for preparing the document; 2) allocation of hours; and 3) scope to include core testing. The response resulted in the revised proposal of \$37,336.54. The committee accepted their response and recommends approving the proposal.
- Motion** With no further discussion, Marilyn Salas motioned to approve \$37,336.54, for Duenas and Camacho to conduct the structural assessment of the San Dionisio Church.
 The motion was seconded by Joaquin Perez and unanimously approved.
- Action** **5.2.b. George Flores House**
 Joe Quinata reported an appraised value of \$88,000.00 for the George Flores property was obtained from the Dept. of Revenue & Tax.
 The property owner agreed to sell the property for the appraised value.
 The Board discussed conducting a feasibility study simultaneously while processing the sale. The feasibility study will accomplish three (3) areas: 1) preservation of the structure; 2) public access; and 3) sustainability.
 The committee agreed the property is in better condition than most of the historic homes in the district and easily adaptable for use in the community.

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Motion

A motion was made by Joaquin Perez to purchase the George Flores property for \$88,000.00 and to conduct the feasibility study and whatever other studies are necessary at the same time.

The floor was opened for discussion.

The Board discussed the urgency of purchasing the property.

The motion was seconded by Marilyn Salas and unanimously approved.



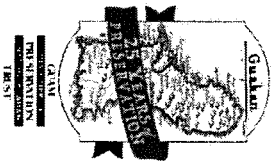
