1.0. CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Michael Makio at 3:20 p.m. and roll call was conducted.

- Chairman Makio reported as a result of the Executive Session the Board discussed and recommends approving a bonus aligned with the current salary effective immediately. With no further discussion, James Viernes motioned in recognition of the GPT staff's achievement of excellence to provide bonuses for each staff member in the amount aligned to the (40) hours paid to each staff member effective immediately. The committee recommended the following options: 1) Disapprove the grant application on the basis of the existing Covenant that expires on 10/10/47; 2) Table until further clarification on the items and justify the cause of the compromised structural integrity other than neglect, and to focus on the work that is preservation related. It was the consensus of the Board to table the application until further information is received from the applicant.

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FQ Sanchez Facility

Chairman Makio reported the committee reviewed and recommended accepting the 100% submittal by RIM Architects and requested the feasibility of the following additives: a) to extend the rear retaining wall, and b) change the windows and swivel glass doors on the east wing of the classrooms.

The motion was seconded by Joaquin Perez and unanimously approved.



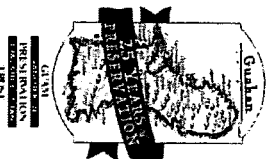
