SCOPE OF SERVICES

The work covered by the Legal Services for RFP 19-03 includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Legal Counsel to the Guam Preservation Trust
- ❖ Provide legal advice, counsel, and render legal services as required by the Guam Preservation Trust, but not limited to the following subject matters: open meetings; public records; human resource; real estate and personal property matters, including acquisitions and sale, annexation, zoning
- Prepare opinions, resolutions, and reports at the request of any member of the Board of Directors or the Chief Program Officer
- Undertake such legal research as shall be requested by the Board of Directors or Chief Program Officer
- Advise the Trust upon request as to needed revisions of the laws of Guam and of the Rules and Regulations of the Trust
- ❖ Advise the Board of Directors and the Chief Program Officer of all legal matters to which the Trust is a party or in which the Trust is legally interested
- Represent the Guam Preservation Trust in connection with legal matters before the Legislature, Boards, and other agencies of the Territory of Guam or the United States

- Represent the Guam Preservation Trust in litigation concerning the affairs of the Trust
- Review and/or prepare contracts, leases, bid invitations, and other documents as may be requested from time to time by the Board of Directors or Chief Program Officer
- Provide legal assistance and advice during any negotiations with the Board of Directors tenants, concessionaires and contractors
- Perform other legal services as requested by the Board of Directors or the Chief Program Officer
- Attend Board of Directors meetings

MINIMINUM WORK EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING:

Over four (4) and less than four (8) years of progressively responsible experience as a licensed attorney and graduation from a law school accredited by the American Bar Association
