Independent Financial Audit Services

The Guam Preservation Trust (GPT), a component unit of the Government of Guam, is soliciting proposals from a U.S. Certified Public Accountant firm for an audit (to include the Single Audit Act Provision, if applicable) of its financial operations for *Fiscal Years 2019 through 2021*, subject to the availability and certification of funds from fiscal year to fiscal year, and with an option to renew for one (1) additional fiscal year, with the approval of the Public Auditor. Required audit reports include a report on the financial statements and reports on internal control and compliance.

Request for Proposal (RFP) packages may be obtained at GPT's main office on 167 Padre Palomo Street, Hagatna, Guam, anytime between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. from Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. The RFP may also be downloaded from the Office of Public Accountability's website at www.opaguam.org. **Deadline for submission of all proposals is no later than 4:00 p.m. on July 23, 2019, Tuesday, Chamorro Standard Time (Guam Time).** All proposals must be submitted to the attention of Joseph Quinata, Chief Program Officer.

GPT, with the written approval of the Public Auditor, reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, solicit new proposals, waive minor informalities or irregularities, or award the Independent Auditor in whole or in part.
