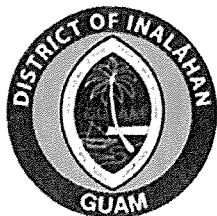

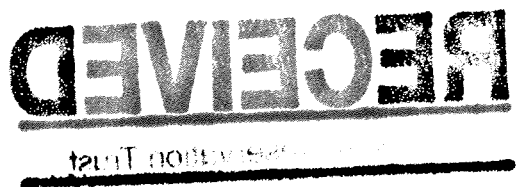
The Inalåhan Baptist Church was built in 1925 and is significant to our village because our office envisions that this project will help the community by showcasing artifacts valuable to the community.

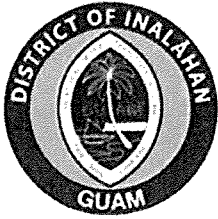

The Inalåhan Mayor's Office under the leadership of Mayor Chargualaf envisions to revitalize Inalåhan by opening its doors to the general public Monday through Saturday, 8am-5pm and the Baptist Church will help this goal.
